



10 DAYS TOUR OF ISRAEL (POSSIBLE ITINERARY) LOW TRAVEL SEASON (\$1995 USD) OR HIGH TRAVEL SEASON (\$2495 USD)

DAY 1 Trans-Atlantic Flight

Depart from the USA to Tel Aviv, Israel. Meals will be served in flight.

DAY 2 Arrival in Tel Aviv

You will arrive at Ben Gurion International Airport in Tel Aviv and transfer to your hotel where you will enjoy dinner and a good night's sleep.

DAY 3 Heading North

Meeting with Tel Aviv congregation (Esther House / Dugit or similar). Learn about the community day to day life and worship. Short visit to the old biblical city of Joppa (Yaffa) related to Jonah, King Solomon, Peter, and Simon the tanner... going on to maritime Caesarea (Cornelius the centurion and other biblical events). At Noon, typical lunch: Israeli Falafel (on your own). On to Mount Carmel (1 Kings 18), Muhraka and Prophet Elijah. Megiddo (Biblical Armageddon) (1 Kings 9:15, Rev. 6:16). Dinner and accommodation Sea of Galilee.

DAY 4 Sea of Galilee

After breakfast visit Mount of Beatitudes (Sermon on the Mount, Matt. 5-7), then to Caesarea Philippi (Peter's confession), traveling to the Golan heights, visit Mt Bental, viewpoint of Israel and Syria border. Return to the Sea of Galilee for a boat ride, as in the time of Yeshua. Enjoy a typical lunch of Saint Peter's fish. Continue to Capernaum to see the Synagogue and Peter's house (Matt. 4:13). Drive to Yardenit (Baptism site). Proceed to visit Igal Alon Museum to see the famous boat from Yeshua's time. Evening visit to the Galilee Experience. Meet with fellow believers and learn about their daily life in the Land. Dinner and accommodation Sea of Galilee.

DAY 5 The Desert, Land of Our Patriarchs

Morning drive via Cana of Galilee to Nazareth, site of Annunciation, childhood and youth of Yeshua (panoramic). Visit Kfar Kedem, a unique Biblical Village, to learn about our ancestors' daily life. Continue via Jordan Valley to the Tabernacle Tent (Kibbutz Almog). On to Qumran, where the famous Dead Sea manuscripts were found. Bathe in the Dead Sea, nice and recommended if weather allows. It is recommended to bring a towel and bathing suit. In the afternoon we will arrive to the Negev desert (Patriarch Abraham, Genesis), where we will have a typical dinner from the desert, and be accommodated in tents, like our ancestors. A unique experience!

DAY 6 Jerusalem

In the morning, ride on camels in the Negev desert. Climb by cable car to visit Masada (Herod's fortress and last point of Jewish resistance against the Romans). Drive to the Holy City of Jerusalem, with a ceremony at the entry of the city at Mount Scopus. Enter the Old City to visit and pray at the Wailing Wall. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem. (If staying in Jerusalem over Friday night, a special Kabbalat Shabat Dinner with the Messianic Community in Yad Hashmona).

DAY 7 Mt. of Olives and the Old City of Jerusalem

Mount of Olives (triumphal entry, prayer, ascension). We walk down toward the Garden of Gethsemane (time for meditation). St. Peter in Gallicantu (palace of Caiaphas. Peter's denial). Pool of Bethesda (healing of the paralytic), Stations of the Cross, toward Golgotha and the Garden Tomb. Holy Communion. Dinner and accommodation in Jerusalem.

DAY 8 Mt. Zion and King David's Tomb

Departing after breakfast to Mount Zion, visiting the Upper Room, King David's tomb, then in the old city, visit to the Temple Institute and the Jewish Quarter, Davidson Center. Afternoon meeting with Messianic local community of Jerusalem. Dinner and accommodation.

Day 9 New City of Jerusalem

Visit the Knesset (Israeli Parliament), the Menorah, Yad Vashem (Holocaust Museum), visit Joseph Store House (a non profit organization which collects donations and contributions for the needy). Proceed to visit the Messianic community and Biblical Garden in Yad Hashmona. We will end our day with a unique visit to the new archeological excavation of the City of David and Hezekiah Tunnel. Farewell dinner in the hotel.

DAY 10 Departure
