



## 12 DAYS OF ISRAEL (POSSIBLE ITENARARY)

LOW TRAVEL SEASON (\$2495 USD) OR HIGH TRAVEL SEASON  
(\$2895 USD)

### **DAY 1 Trans-Atlantic Flight**

Depart from North America to Tel Aviv, Israel. Meals will be served in flight.

### **DAY 2 Arrival in Tel Aviv**

You will arrive at Ben Gurion International Airport in Tel Aviv and transfer to your hotel where you will enjoy dinner and a good night's sleep.

### **DAY 3 Head North**

Meet with a Tel Aviv congregation (Esther House / Dugit or similar). Learn about the community's day to day life and worship. Enjoy a short visit to the old biblical city of Joppa (Yaffa) related to Jonah, King Solomon, Peter and Simon the tanner. Continue to maritime Caesarea to learn about Cornelius the centurion and other biblical events. At noon, enjoy a typical Israeli lunch such as Falafel (on your own). Travel to Mount Carmel (1 Kings 18) to hear of Murrakh and Prophet Elijah. Your next stop is Megiddo, Biblical Armageddon (1 Kings 9:15, Rev. 6:16). Dinner and accommodation at the Sea of Galilee.

### **DAY 4 Sea of Galilee**

After breakfast visit Mount of Beatitudes (Sermon on the , Matt. 5-7). then to Caesarea Philippi (Peter's confession), traveling to the Golan heights, visit Mt Bental, viewpoint of Israel and Syria border. Return to the Sea of Galilee for a boat ride, as in the time of Yeshua. Typical lunch (Saint Peter's Then to Capernaum (Synagogue and Peter's house Matt. 4:13). Drive to Yardenit (Baptism site). Proceed to visit Igal Alon Museum, to see the famous boat from Yeshua' time. Evening visit to the Galilee Experience, meeting with fellow believers, learning about their daily life in the Land. Dinner and accommodation Sea of Galilee.

### **DAY 5 A Day in Galilee and Nazareth**

Visit Safed, city of the Kabbalah, to visit synagogue and the artists' quarter. Proceed to Kfar Kedem, a unique Biblical Village, to learn about our ancestors' daily life and to Nazareth, site of the Annunciation, childhood and youth of Yeshua (panoramic). Drive via Cana of Galilee to plant a tree with your own hands and back to our hotel. Dinner and accommodation Sea of Galilee.

### **DAY 6 The Desert, Land of Our Patriarchs**

Departing the Galilee to visit Beit Shean. On via Jordan Valley to the Tabernacle Tent (Kibbutz Almog). On to Qumran, where the famous Dead Sea manuscripts were found. Bath in the Dead Sea, nice and recommended if the weather allows. It is recommended that you bring a towel and bathing suit. In the afternoon we will arrive to the Negev desert (Patriarch Abraham, Genesis), where we will have a typical dinner from the desert, and we will be accommodated in tents, like our ancestors. A unique experience!

### **DAY 7 To Jerusalem!**

In the morning, ride on camels in the Negev desert. Climb by cable car to visit Masada (Herod's fortress and last point of Jewish resistance against the Romans). Drive to the Holy City of Jerusalem, with a ceremony at the entry of the city at Mount Scopus. Enter the Old City to visit and pray at the Wailing Wall. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem. (If staying in Jerusalem over Friday night, a special Kabbalat Shabbat Dinner with the Messianic Community in Yad Hashmona).

### **DAY 8 Mt. of Olives and the Old City of Jerusalem**

Mount of Olives (triumphal entry, prayer, ascension). We walk down toward the Garden of Gethsemane (time for meditation). St. Peter in Gallicantu (palace of Caiaphas. Peter's denial). Pool of Bethesda (healing of the paralytic), Stations of the Cross, toward Golgotha and the Garden Tomb. Holy Communion. Dinner and accommodation in Jerusalem.

**DAY 9 Mt. Zion and King David's Tomb**

Departing after breakfast to Mount Zion, visiting the Upper Room, King David's tomb, then in the old city, visit to the Temple Institute and the Jewish Quarter, Davidson Center. Afternoon meeting with Messianic local community of Jerusalem. Dinner and accommodation.

**DAY 10 New City of Jerusalem**

See the Knesset (Israeli Parliament), the Menorah, Yad Vashem (Holocaust Museum), visit Joseph Store House (a non profit organization which collects donations and contributions for the needy). Proceed to visit the Messianic community and Biblical Garden in Yad Hashmona. We will end our day with a unique visit to the new archeological excavation of the City of David and Hezekiah Tunnel. Farewell dinner in the hotel.

**DAY 11 Day at Leisure**

Full day at leisure to see more of the interesting sites in Jerusalem on your own. Head to the Airport for a night flight back.

**DAY 12 Depart for North America**
